THE CORNER CAMARO

This months' CORNER CAMARO is Paul Trickett's 2000 Z28, his 8th Camaro. It has the 5.7 LS1 with a 6 speed manual trans. The exterior color is Silver with an Ebony leather interior. Bought it 10 years ago after deciding it was now or never to buy my last Camaro before retirement. I had been looking for a while and had just bought a 98 RS with a bad V6 with the idea of an engine swap. A few weeks later I saw this one on Auto Trader and it fit the bill. I wanted a Z28 or SS with a 6 speed. I went to look at it and the fellow was a nice guy from the Air Force at Selfridge that was being sent to Italy for at least 2 years. He bought it when it was only 1 year old and it was never driven in the winter. Lots of highway trips to Cincinnati had clocked it up to 125K miles. It was a little rough but had every option available in 2000 so I wanted it. He had a few buyers that he felt were wanting it cheap to flip. I talked to him for 1/2an hour and he realized I was a true Camaro nut and would give it a good home. First thing after selling the 98 RS was to buy new wheels and tires. The muffler was leaking so on went a nice Magnaflow stainless cat back with a SLP y pipe and I welded up a custom set of stainless cat pipes. Not stopping there I put a SLP air box with K&N filter. Off to Jakes in Utica for a good dyno tune and I had one great running Camaro. The last thing was SLP subframe connectors and a strut tower brace just in time for a EMCC outing at Waterford Hills. I smiled for weeks after that blast around the track. Having owned 6 Z28's, 1 RS and 1 RS/SS I found this one the best bang for the buck. Still want my original Camaro back I just need to hit the lottery. It's a butternut yellow 67 Z28 fully restored in the Reggie Jackson collection that I bought for my 18th birthday. Incidentally, the car name on the packaging is incorrectly spelled "Camero." This boxcar is in bright blue with block lettered Camaro stretches across the top. On one side of the car is a 67 Camaro RS and a 69 Camaro SS. On the other side there's the same red 69 Camaro from the first side posed at a different angle and a 70 lime green Camaro Z-28 along with a scripted Camaro emblem.

Another piece of is the Lionel Chevy Vintage Boxcar, SKU# 21-28160 painted in black and silver. There is a beautiful C7 Corvette and a 1973 Camaro on one side of the boxcar. 


