THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro goes to EMCC member Mark Harpootlian and his 1969 Camaro coupe. It's most unsettling that Mark's turn is right after his passing. The story of his Camaro is -

I found my '69 Camaro on the internet in the Summer of 2000. Sharon and I drove from our home in Southfield, MI to Albany, NY to bring it home on a trailer. The car could barely make it onto the trailer and I said to myself, "Oh no, what have I done!"

A previous owner had put in a 327 and drag raced it. My goal was to turn it into a driver, restored back to 1969, not necessarily original or factory-fresh, but something that would at least be authentic to the period.

The car felt like it was starting up in second gear all the time due to the Muncie's close ratio 2:20 first gear. I shopped around for a 3:11 Saginaw - much more conducive to cruising around town and creeping along Woodward Avenue in the annual Dream Cruise. I put in a new clutch, too. One that was used in the 307's and 6 cylinder Chevy's. It has nice easy feel. It shifts really nice now, very smooth and effortless.

The car still rode pretty harsh, so off came the traction bars, air shocks and heavy-duty rear leafs. I put on the standard 5-leaf springs which were 15% softer than what the drag racer had used. That was a lot of work, especially since someone had WELDED the front leaf spring brackets to the underbody!

Other improvements included a front spoiler, new grill, bumpers, various emblems, marker lights, outside mirrors, weatherstripping, wheels and tires.

The biggest improvement by far was when I had the car painted. I kept the original Frost Green color and the twin black rally stripes, which it had when I got the car but probably weren't original. They just look cool.

There are still more things that I want to do, but for now, I just enjoy driving it. It gets out several times a week when the weather's good. I get a lot of looks, waves, and thumbs-ups and that makes it all worthwhile.

We also honor Sharon Harpootlian and her Camaro - 2016 Camaro Coupe. The Camaro has a V6 engine and 6 speed auto manual trans. The exterior color is Garnet Red and the interior color is Gray. A nice gray stripe was added to give the Camaro a great accent! Sharon does drive this Camaro all year long! NICE RIDE!!


To complete Mark's legacy with EMCC, we are donating \$2000 to Detroit Rescue Mission Ministries in the name of Mark Harpootlian.


