## THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro goes to EMCC members Kathy & Paul Denski, members #397. With several Camaros to choose from, they selected the 2010 RS/SS "McDreame" to highlight in this HUGGER. Here's the story-

It was October 20th 2008, that was the day you could actually order a new Camaro for the first time in a long time. I remember it well. On the way to work I stopped by our old sponsors dealership and tried to order Kathy's. Not so fast, as they did not have the software as of 9am. OK, so I would return after work. It was a loooonnnngggg day at work. Returning to the showroom and capturing my Salesman we sat down to a short discussion about what I wanted. Everything comes to mind. IBM (indigo blue metallic) 6 speed, no stripes (not a fan of the vinyl at the time) RS/SS 2SS option. All that was offered at the time.

Arriving home slightly late for dinner, Kathy asked "where ya been?" And after stuttering several times in an attempt to hide the facts, she busted me. "What color?" Was the next question she asked. "Blue", I said. "Nope, I want red", and the phone call to our salesman ensued. "What color red is offered?" Her question posed, he responded with two shades and Kathy insisted upon something akin to Firetruck Red

and that turns out to be Victory Red. And so it was to be. We waited just short of 6 months (April 15th, 2009) to take delivery of the first 5th Generation Camaro delivered to the public in Michigan. Racing each other from work when they called, Kathy arrived first, giving her the advantage to look, sit in and inspect what would become her "McDreme". We then proceeded to have the first known modification made to the new generation Camaro. Custom painted black stripes under multiple layers of clear. Only to find out that GM wanted it back! That's right, it escaped from the factory without the necessary QC checks at the time. "Do you think they will notice the stripes?" inquired Scott. I guess we will find out. They actually sent a truck to pick it up. Needless to say, we took official delivery some two weeks later. It was love at first sight, Kathy and McDreme together for ever. Still her favorite, 40,000+ miles and several other Camaros later. Don't let her fool you, if there was a choice between me and, well, it wouldn't end well for me. She makes it clear on each trip we take what Camaro we take. Occasionally I win, but I think she just feels bad for me at times.


