## THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro goes to EMCC member #413 Ken Ross and his 1967 Camaro. Here is his and his Camaro's story.....

This month's Corner Camaro was left for dead in Detroit. You could call it a barn find. I was looking for a 1969 Chevelle SS convertible back in 2005-06.

A friend told me about this 1967 Camaro in a garage in Brightmore. The car was covered in 10 years' worth of dust and had rodents living in and under the car along with cob-webs that you could cut with a machete. We made a deal on Woodward cruise morning 2006.

After having all the sheet metal acid dipped with absolutely no rust found, I realized what I had. Researching all the paper work and VIN number I found that the car was built in California where it stayed until 1994 when it was sold to the lady I bought it off of.

Funny side note: after having it acid & primer dipped I brought to the 2007 Camaro Superfest in Ypsi on a flat bed trailer and had it for sale. Everyone thought I was trying to pull a fast one with a

Dynacorn body, with no interested buyers I decided to dive in. This was a 3 year transformation into a ProTouring Restomod, completed in August of 2009 with all the original sheet metal. The engine is an aluminum LS! with a  $4L60\bar{E}$  automatic transmission and rack a pinion steering system. It has a TCI tubular frame with a four-link rear suspension, 9" Ford 3:71 rear end, adjustable coil overs and disc brakes at each 17" Crager SS wheel. The interior is 2002 Trans Am leather Buckets with original rear seat covered to match, console is from a 97 Trans Am. The paint is House of Kolor Brandywine Candy with a silver underlay.

I wanted something totally different from original without modifying the body, like Old school vs New school and a wolf in sheep's clothing. I am really happy with the outcome, it handles great, its reliable and just plain fun to drive. It's not a trailer queen if you know what I mean! Let the Good Times Roll.




