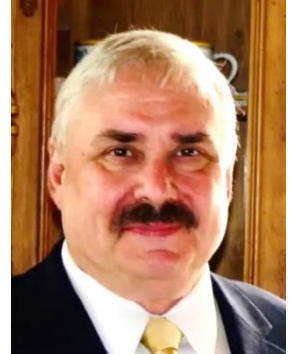
We are saddened to inform EMCC members of the passing of EMCC member Raleigh Ormerod. Raleigh passed just after the April HUGGER had been published. Here is his obituary -

Raleigh Clair

Ormerod III passed away peacefully on March 29, 2025, in his home surrounded by loved ones.

Born in St. Louis, Missouri, to Raleigh Clair Ormerod II and Lola Olivia Zelle

Ormerod, Raleigh lived a life of intellect, curiosity, and quiet strength. As a young man, he earned the rank of Eagle Scout, a reflection of his dedication and perseverance. He later attended Texas A&M University, where he obtained his PhD in Physical Chemistry, laying the foundation for a distinguished career. Raleigh had a sharp mind and a deep appreciation for technology, science fiction, philosophy, and astronomy. He was endlessly fascinated by the mysteries of the universe and had a love for anything that stimulated the intellect. He worked in the automotive industry for many years and was especially passionate about Camaros, owning several throughout his life-most recently, his beloved 2012 Camaro. He is survived by his wife, Carol, his four children and his three stepdaughters, as well as his 15 grandchildren. A celebration of life will be held in June for close family and friends. While I was in college from '66-'70, I didn't have many opportunities to work on the family cars as I did while growing up at home, but always loved 'em. One day while outside my dorm, I was so lucky to see a '69, Z-28, lime green with white stripes, lake pipes and huge meats, slowly drive past my dorm, I was entranced. I'm sure I stood there staring with my mouth open. It must have had a performance cam because it sounded so awesome. I was in love! After graduation in '70 and getting my first job I was convinced, for some reason, that I was going to buy a new, red vette... not sure why. But instead I chose a '71 black Z-28 with white stripes. It had a 350 c.i. engine, 330 hp and a Hurst 4 speed. I got it from Mark Chevrolet on Michigan Ave, in Wayne. I was in love all over again. In '72, Jo Ann and I were married... how much better could life get, a new Z-28 and a new wife... all of this was in 1972 B.C. (before children). It just had to go... we needed a 'practical ride". It was a sad day for me but at least I had it for about 5 years. In 2009 and being empty nesters, I was able to relive my dream... a new Camaro. Since owning SSSEYYA, that's it's name, I've boosted the performance with the aid of Livernois Engineering. I added tuned headers, hi-flow cats and Corsa cat-backs. It also has new wheels that have a set-back to allow 315 rear tires and 275' in the front. I'd love to be able to do a few more tweaks but can't justify the cost, yet. Nevertheless, I love

the car and, in fact, it's actually in my will giving it to the kids. One more tidbit, come July 3rd, 2025, SSSEYYA will turn "sweet 16"! And, that's my story. Great Camaro and story John!! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!

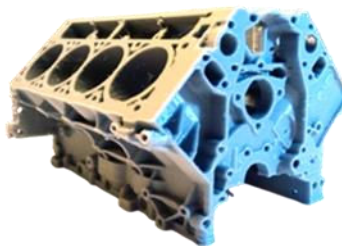
