Here is their story - Our Camaro story begins in White Plains, New York, the original owner, GMC, Powertrain Division, took delivery of a 1968 base model, 327, Camaro, produced at the Norwood, Ohio Plant. This Camaro then went thru several owners and was completely restored in 1985-86 and ended up in Holden, MA, about 50 miles west of Boston. This Camaro 'story' requires a brief step back in time and has a connection to three families and four daughters thru Girl Scouts. Our daughters grew up and were members of a Girl Scout Troup, with the daughters of Kathy & Paul (Snook) Denski and Roxanne & Chuck England. Since owning this '68 Camaro, we have made a few small changes, such as the 'bumble bee' stripe around front end and converting from column shift to console shift. 
