THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro is EMCC member #80 Fred and Pat Weber and his 1972 Z-28! Here is their story - I'll be the first to tell you that I am new to EMCC. The Friday before Camaro SuperFest 2024, I was at the weekly Friday night cruise at Multi Lakes. One of the club officers came by and twisted my arm to bring our car to CSF. Long story short, I entered for Saturday and then decided to join the club. By the way, my wife is Pat and she attended with me. Some friends in our neighborhood talked us into trying the Hot Rod Power Tour this year.

I ordered the Z/28 from the same small town Chevy dealer that sold my father his first new car. In fact, it was the same salesman. I know my choices were not what most people would have ordered but I was 18 years old and had just started college at General Motors Institute. The Z/28 part was easy, and I liked the color but went with white stripes instead of black. OK, yes, I decided to choose the automatic. I've never regretted that decision. Turns out the auto with 3.73 gears could pull an identical Z/28 4-speed with 4.10 gears every time from a light. (Or my friend in the army could not launch his car. But he was not happy.) Here are the significant changes that have been made to the car: Steering wheel is an Oldsmobile 4 spoke "sport option". I worked for the GM Division that made steering wheels and we could legally request one part per year at the time. Score a nice steering wheel. I'm old enough to have experienced the 55 MPH National Speed Limit. One day I made a trip on the expressway for about 25 miles at 55 MPH. Stopped at the bottom of the exit ramp and ran it through the gears. The car was "loaded up" and missing at high RPM. (Anyone old enough to remember breaker points for ignition?) The posi clutches were worn so it was going in for rear end work. I had them drop in a 4.56 gear set while they were at

it. Lost the AIR pump and of course put on headers. Many sets to date the first being side mount headers with side-pipes. Painted them white and also painted the wheels white. The car sat in storage for about 20 years as we did kids and boats. About 5 years ago we put it back on the road. Here are the significant things done since then: Turbo-400 rebuilt. Instrument cluster rebuilt with GM approved aftermarket tach (appropriate Z/28 yellow and red line markings) and oil pressure gage replacing the clock. 2.5 inch Flow Master exhaust and Hooker headers, both in stainless. I love having that muffler hanging behind the differential again (no more mufflers hanging down!). Getting ready for Power Tour, the front seats were recovered, new carpet, and a 9-inch touch screen radio that supports Car Play via Bluetooth.

OK, now for the disappointing news about Power Tour 2025. Pat and I left home on Sunday to cruise to Indianapolis, IN but we had our problems. In Byron, Ohio we "let the smoke out". Broken screw in rocker stud on number 8 intake. I checked that no stray bits escaped and decided to put the valve cover back on and try to limp to Indy. A replacement stud was a next day item from any of the parts stores. We were rolling into Fort Wayne, IN and all heck broke loose. This time it was the number 2 intake with the rocker arm ball over half worn away. Not getting enough oil past number 8 with just the lifter there. That was it, we raised the white flag. Fortunately, I had left the car trailer hooked up to the pick up and our youngest daughter was on call to rescue. A couple of guys from the neighborhood helped her load Pat's Malibu on the trailer and she came to rescue us. We swapped the cars on the trailer and we were then in what Power Tour folks call "Plan B".

Power Tour was still a great time and it is tough to explain what a rolling 5-day car show with over 6,000 cars per day looks like. We highly recommend the experience.

Here's a few more specs on the Camaro.... In 1972 only 68,651 Camaros were built due to an extended strike at the Norwood, Ohio assembly Plant. This car is an "L" code engine documenting that it is one of only 2,575 Z/28's built in 1972. The color is Spring Green (code 36) available on Camaro only in 1972. For $\mathbb{Z}/28$ only, the automatic transmission option delivered a THM-400 with a 2400 RPM stall torque converter. 1972 had mid-model year changes introduced which included the 3point shoulder harness and a seat belt warning light/buzzer. This car was ordered from the factory by it's current owner in the Fall of 1971. And yes, that means 53 years and counting of ownership. As of today, I have the Z/28 most of the way back together so it should make it to Camaro SuperFest. Hope to see you there! Great Story Fred & Pat! And a great Camaro in EMCC! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!




