THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro is EMCC member #84 Matt Murphy In 1969, Chevrolet built 69 ZL1 Camaros. The cars, which sold for around \$7,500, had a 427 aluminum engine rated at a conservative 430

HP. Today these are highly

collectible and go for big

money.

The car in the foreground of the picture is the third '69 ZL1 built in



Daytona yellow and was bought by Dale Berger Jr. of Berger Chevrolet in Grand Rapids, Michigan. Berger has a reputation over the years of selling high performance Chevy vehicles and muscle car parts. Turns out, the car sat on the dealership showroom floor for about a year before it sold because it was so expensive! (It was reported that this car sold several years back for over a million dollars.) Fast forward to February 9th, 2011 at the Chicago Auto Show when Chevy announces the return of the ZL1 nameplate on the 2012 Camaro after 43 years. It was not a 427, but it did have a formable 6.2L inter-cooled and supercharged LSA motor, magnetic shocks, Brembo brakes on 20" wheels. When Dale's son Matt Berger, who was now running the dealership got wind of this, he made a plea to Chevrolet that the third 2012 ZL1 had to be yellow and it had to be allocated to Berger Chevrolet! As a result of Matt's persistence, GM built the car to that spec and Matt Berger put it in his private collection where it stayed until 2021. Matt had his team at the dealership paint the rear valence to match the Berger Camaro paint scheme as well as Berger badging and floor mats. It became part of our collection in 2021. Great Story Matt! And a great Camaro in EMCC! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!
