This month's Corner Camaro is EMCC member #113 Michael Foster with his 2014 2SS. Here's Michael and Dawn Foster's Story-







In the past, we've owned a 1976 RS, a 1978 RS, and a 1985 IROC Camaro. When the Gen 5 came out I thought it was time for another one. I spent over a year looking for exactly what I wanted. It had to be black, as I only drive black cars, also had to be a 2SS, 6

speed manual, and a convertible. In July of 2018 I finally found the exact one, but it was in Florida. I called Garber Automall in Green Cove Springs. I explained what I was looking for and expressed my deep concern about buying a car sight unseen. I asked to have the car inspected "like he was going to buy it himself". They sent me almost 20 photos of the car. He zoomed in on minor paint defects smaller than a pencil lead. The car looked great for being 4 years old and having less than 30,000 miles on it. I flew into Jacksonville and was picked up at the airport by one of the dealer's porters. (It turns out his previous job was in the same industry our family has been in for 100 years.) The paperwork was complete by the time I got to the dealership. The car was washed and filled with gas for my 1000-mile drive home. As it turned out the exhaust had been upgraded with aftermarket mufflers, the tires were new, and the sound system was better than noted. My fears of buying a car sight unseen were completely unfounded. I was so impressed by the honesty of the dealership in Florida I wrote a letter to Mr. Richard Garber the President of Garber Group Automotive in Saginaw, thanking him for employing people of integrity. He graciously responded with a personal note. Other than the aftermarket mufflers the only other upgrade has been the addition of a CAI Inductions cold air box. After 7 years of ownership the car just turned over 60,000 miles. After driving my 2014 Camaro my sister-in-law and her husband BOTH bought new Gen 6 Camaros. Great Story Mike and Dawn! And a great Camaro in EMCC! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!

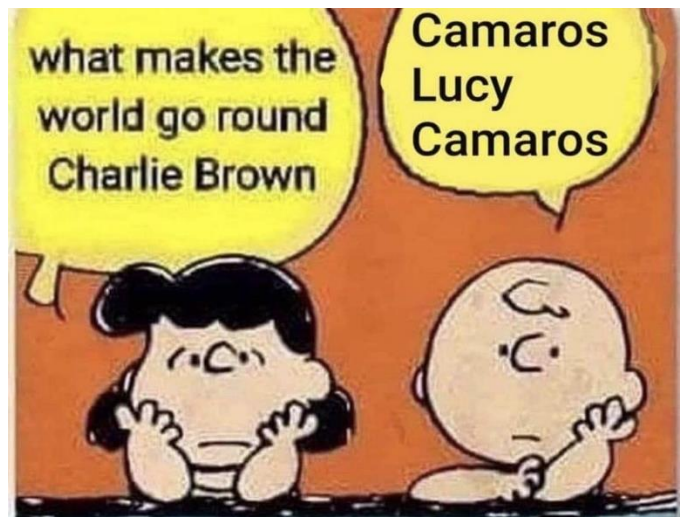

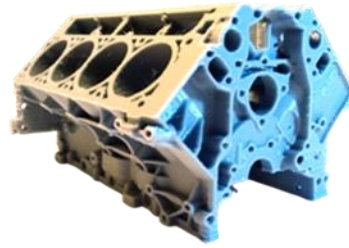

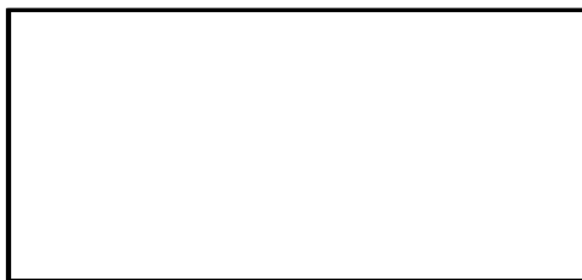
