

THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro is EMCC member #85 Tom Grabowski and his 2024 Camaro RS. Here's Tom's Story- My Camaro story spans multiple decades. In the fall of 1988, I purchased a run down, rusty 1969 Frost Green Camaro with a 307 V8 engine and an automatic transmission. My plan, along with my son, was to repair the '69 and enjoy driving and attending car shows with it. By the time we completed our repairs, the engine was changed to a 350 V8, the color became Fathom Green and a 4-speed transmission was added. My son and I thoroughly enjoyed the time spent together bonding and working on that vehicle. When my son graduated from GMI, his first new car purchase was a 1995 Camaro. I kept the 1969 until 2003 and eventually sold it to my boss's daughter. I continue to hear about the many adventures of the '69, since I am still in contact with my former boss.

For the next 19 years, I was heavily involved with the NCRS (National Corvette Restorers Society). I got hooked on Corvettes with two of my neighbors and eventually owned a 1979 T-Top Coupe and a 2000 Fixed Roof Coupe. Both Corvettes were manual transmissions. The arrival of the pandemic eliminated our opportunity to hold monthly meetings or hold judging events. The Corvettes just sat. I eventually sold them off by 2022. There were no longer any "toys" in my garage.

In December of 2024, I started to look for a new Camaro. Since production was ending that month, I started looking for new vehicles at Chevrolet dealers. My first thought was to get an LT1 with a manual transmission. Our son suggested that I drive a V8 equipped vehicle before I make a hasty decision. He said that since I wanted it as a daily driver, I might not enjoy the stiffness of the suspension for everyday use. He gave me some good advice. I ended up purchasing a Nitro Yellow

Metallic Rally Sport Coupe, with a V6 and the 6-Speed. It has added a great deal of joy to my daily driving experience. Great story Tom! And a great Camaro in EMCC! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!






