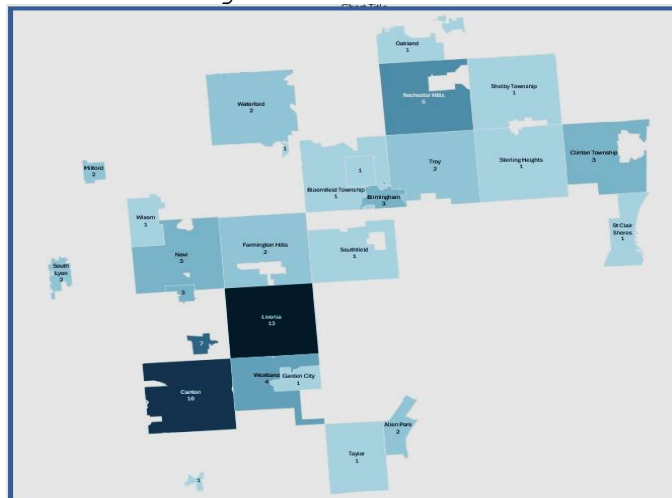

THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro is EMCC member Joel Trautner and his '67 Camaro RS - ***A Family Legacy Reborn: The 1967 Camaro RS That Refused to Fade Away***

Some cars are simply machines—metal, rubber, and horsepower assembled for the road. Others become something more. They carry stories, memories, and the unmistakable imprint of family history. This 1967 Camaro RS is one of those rare automobiles—a car that has traveled not just miles, but generations.

The story begins with a father's gift. Purchased as a first car for his daughter, the Camaro quickly became more than transportation. It was a symbol of independence, youth, and the open road. For approximately sixteen years, she drove the car faithfully, creating memories that would last far beyond the life of its original run on the pavement.

Eventually, as life moved forward, a new vehicle replaced the Camaro. Like many classics of its era, it was parked—this time in a quiet pole barn—where it would rest undisturbed. What was meant to be temporary turned into decades. For roughly 42 years, the 1967 Camaro RS sat in stillness, patiently waiting for its next chapter.

That chapter began about five years ago, when the family made a decision: it was time to bring the Camaro back to life.

The car was entrusted to Slims Body Works in Freeland, Michigan, where Doug Slim and his skilled crew took on the challenge. What they saw was not just an aging vehicle, but the potential to restore a piece of history. With craftsmanship, dedication, and a clear vision, they began transforming the long-resting Camaro into something extraordinary.

Their work went far beyond a simple restoration. Every detail was carefully considered, returning the car to its original form while elevating it to a level

of excellence worthy of the show circuit. The result was nothing short of remarkable—a rebirth that honored the car's past while showcasing the artistry of true automotive restoration.

The accolades soon followed. In 2025, the Camaro earned Top Quality Car of Class at Autorama, was selected by the Multi Lakes Conservation Association Pic of Show, and claimed First in Class at Camaro Superfest. That same year, it achieved one of the highest honors in the Camaro community—a Gold Medal at the Camaro Nationals.

The momentum carried into 2026, when the car was awarded Car of the Show at Back to the Bricks Chrome and Ice, solidifying its place among the elite in classic car circles.

But beyond the trophies and recognition, something even more meaningful emerged from the journey.

While attending Camaro Superfest in 2025, the family connected with fellow enthusiasts—people who shared not only a passion for cars, but a deep appreciation for the stories behind them. Those connections led to joining the Eastern Michigan Camaro Club, a community that has since become an important part of the experience. The camaraderie, shared knowledge, and mutual respect within the club have added a new dimension to the Camaro's story.

Today, the 1967 Camaro RS stands as more than a restored vehicle. It is a testament to family heritage, patience, and the power of revival. From a young woman's first car to decades of quiet storage, and finally to an award-winning showpiece, its journey is one of resilience and rediscovery.

In every polished panel and every turn of the key, the car tells its story—a story that proves some things are simply too meaningful to leave behind.

Great story Joel! And a great Camaro in EMCC! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!
